

# Big John's Family Fireworks Safety Guide

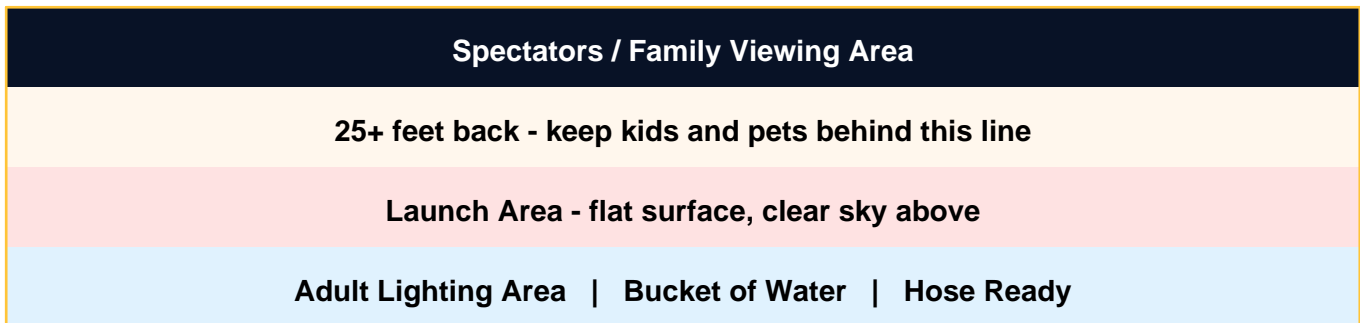
Use this printable guide before, during, and after your backyard celebration. Keep it with your fireworks and review it with everyone before the show starts.

Before You Light	During The Show	After The Show
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read every product label</li> <li>• Choose a flat outdoor launch area</li> <li>• Keep kids and pets back</li> <li>• Have water and a hose ready</li> <li>• Check wind and weather first</li> <li>• Wear eye protection</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adults only should light fireworks</li> <li>• Light one item at a time</li> <li>• Move away quickly after lighting</li> <li>• Never aim fireworks at people</li> <li>• Never hold lit fireworks in your hand</li> <li>• Never use alcohol while lighting</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Never relight a dud</li> <li>• Wait at least 20 minutes</li> <li>• Soak used fireworks in water</li> <li>• Dispose of soaked items safely</li> <li>• Clean up debris the next morning</li> <li>• Store unused fireworks cool and dry</li> </ul>

## Firework Dud Rule

**If a firework does not go off, do not walk up to it and do not try to relight it. Wait at least 20 minutes, then soak it completely with water before disposal.**

# Emergency and Storage Reminders

## Emergency Steps

For serious injury, fire, or emergency, call 911 immediately. For minor burns, cool the area with clean running water and seek medical help if needed. Keep a charged phone nearby during your show.

## Storage and Transportation

Keep fireworks cool and dry. Do not leave fireworks near heat, sparks, flame, or direct sun inside a hot vehicle longer than necessary. Keep fireworks out of reach of children and pets.

## Weather Safety

Do not light fireworks during storms, heavy rain, high winds, or when dry grass and brush create a fire risk. Check Big John's Fireworks Forecast before lighting.

## Respect Neighbors and Local Rules

Fireworks rules can vary by city, county, and event. Follow Kentucky law, local restrictions, product instructions, and posted safety notices. Be respectful of neighbors, veterans, pets, livestock, and quiet hours.
